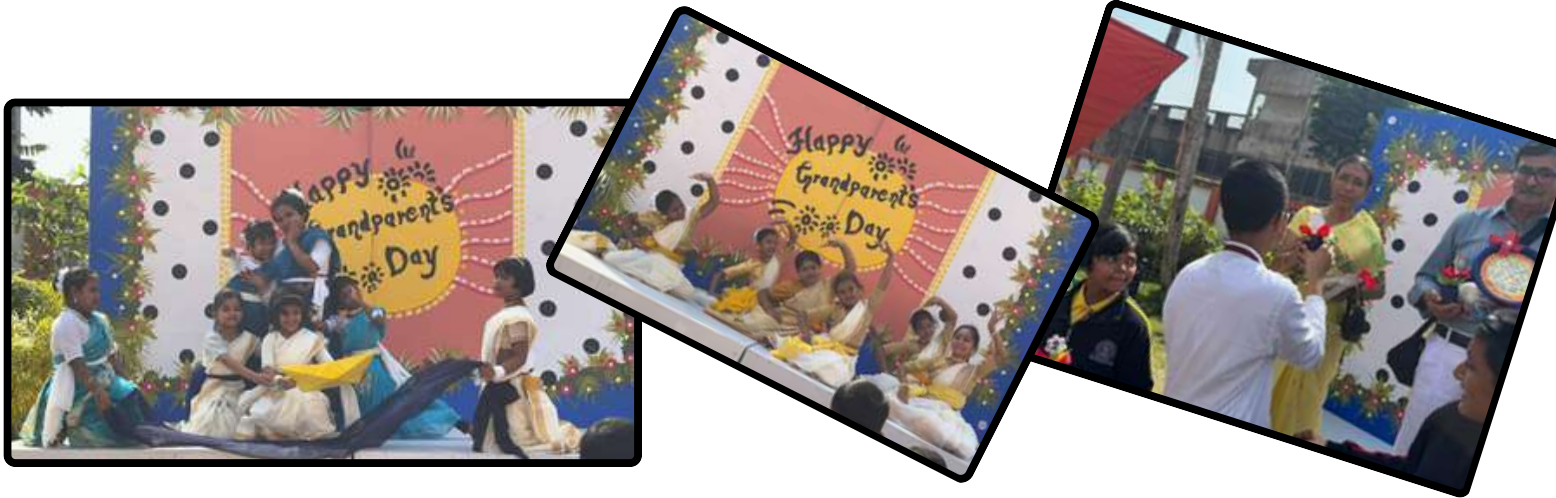

ART EXHIBITION

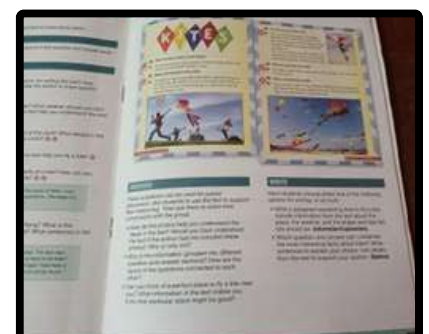
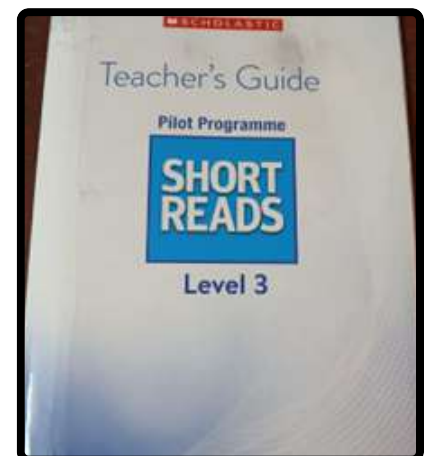
