CHHATH PUJA

विवेकानंदा मिशन विद्यालय में छठ पूजा के अवसर पर एक विशेष कार्यक्रम का आयोजन किया गया। इस कार्यक्रम का मुख्य उद्देश्य भारत की समृद्ध सांस्कृतिक परंपराओं को समझना, सम्मान देना और विद्यार्थियों में regional diversity के प्रति जागरूकता पैदा करना था। छठ पूजा सूर्य देव और छठी मैया को समर्पित एक प्रमुख पर्व है, जिसे विशेष रूप से बिहार, झारखंड, उत्तर प्रदेश और देश के कई अन्य भागों में अत्यंत श्रद्धा और भक्ति के साथ मनाया जाता है। इस पर्व के महत्व, पर्यावरण से इसके गहरे संबंध और अनुशासन, शुद्धता एवं संयम के संदेश को बताया।

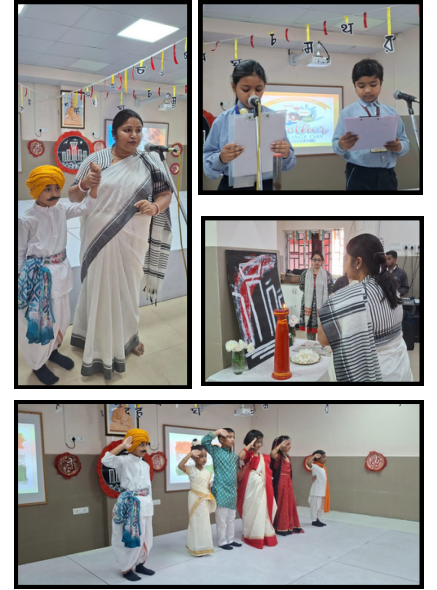
আন্তর্জাতিক মাতৃভাষা দিবস -
