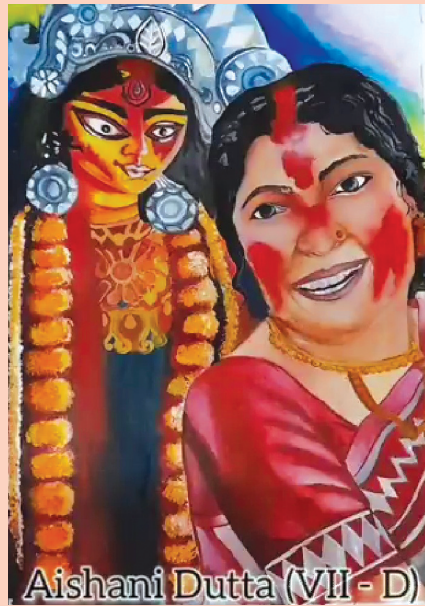


# VIVEKANANDA MISSION SCHOOL JOKA

Children's Day was observed by the teachers, virtually. On this occasion, teachers put up recitation, songs, motivational speeches, etc

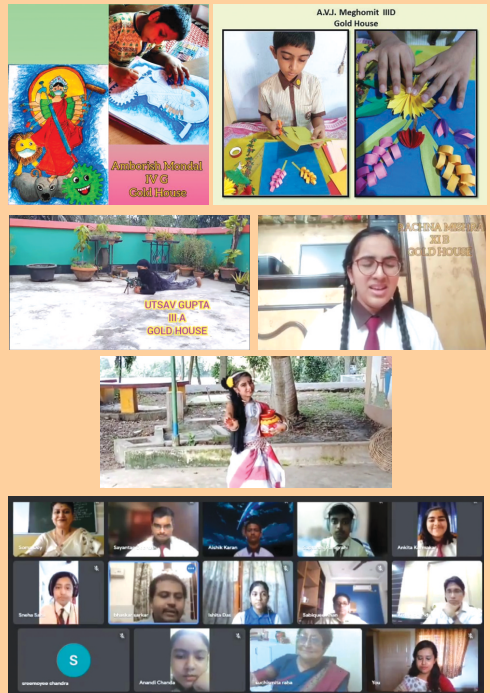
