work and many more. Teachers questioned the students on the history behind the art work of different districts and their uniqueness.


The result of Photography and Documentary competition based on the club members visit to Alipore Jail Museum was also published.

Assembly programme by Unit I and II students who participated with full of enthusiasm.


Assembly talk was held followed by a Bengali poem, Saraswati mantra and a group song.



The excursion included a visit to the science fair, magic show, 3D shows, replica of coal mines, live experiments and a tour of BITM gallery.


