They witnessed the process of amplification of genes by PCR, agarose gel electrophoresis and production of salt resistant rice varieties by insertion of genes. They learnt about genome editing while interacting with the research scholars in the laboratory. The practical demonstrations brought theoretical concepts to life which greatly benefitted the students.
