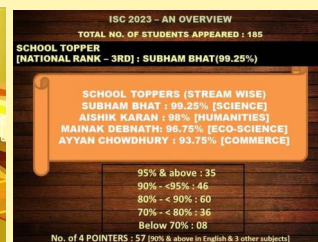

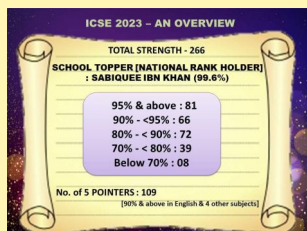

On **International Family day**, Assembly talk was presented on the extended family concept and the children brought pictures of their family.

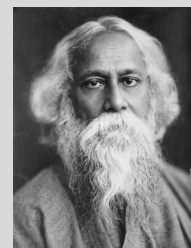

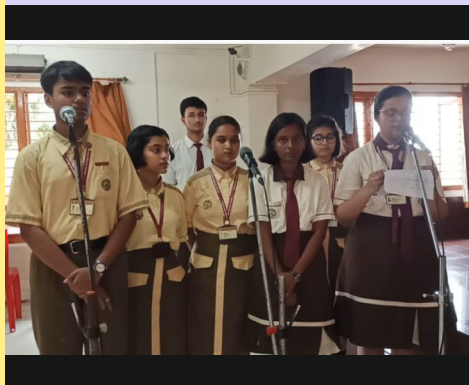

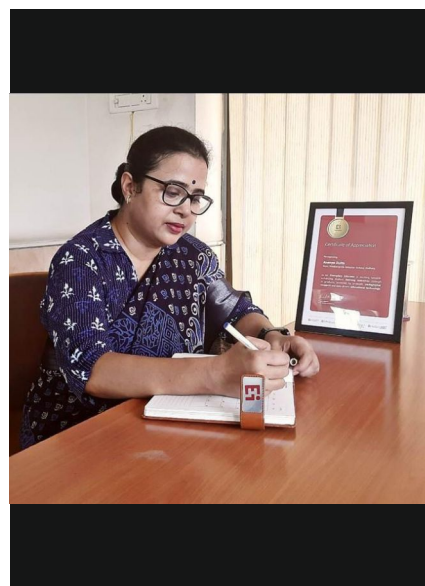
