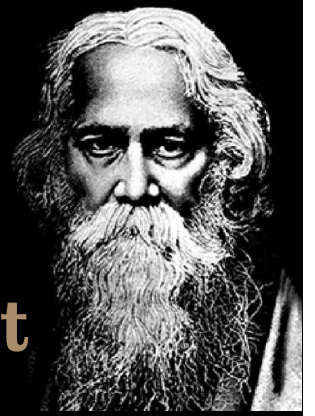

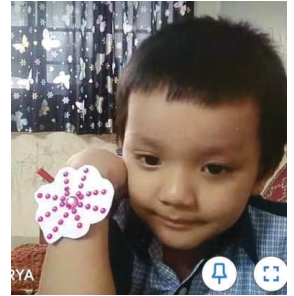
National Sports Day

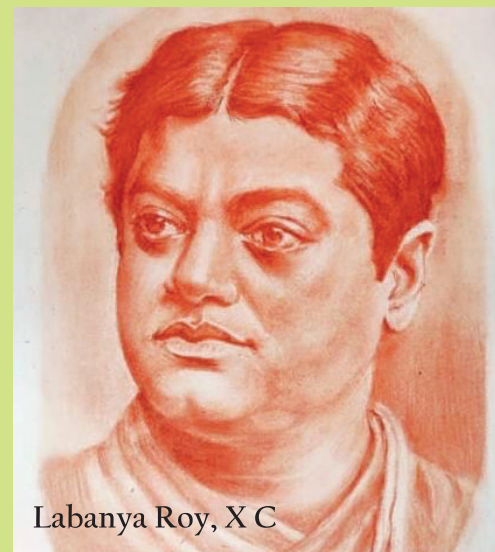
